It is a tool of easy practical use. Posts are inserted by the technician in charge of the blog on demand by the partner – languages available: English, Italian, French, Portuguese. The public is thus able to interact by entering their own comments and/or related news –same languages available.

To enter comments, some personal data are required, such as:

- name (compulsory)
- e-mail (compulsory)
- age
- nationality
- gender
- city of residence

The required data are considered to be useful to monitor external accesses to the blog in terms of age, gender, and nationality. All the data are collected and processed for statistics and assessment.

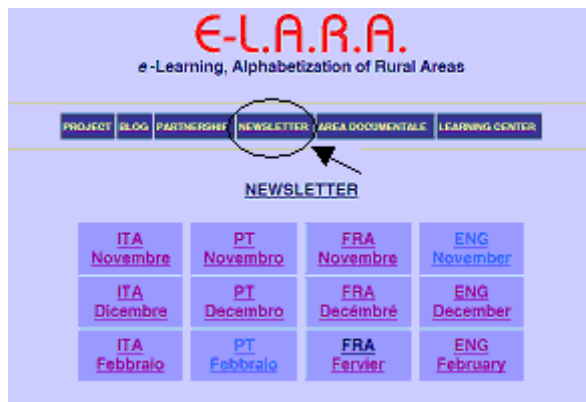

The L. C. is proposed and transferred as a model in the three countries involved in the project according to the following procedure:

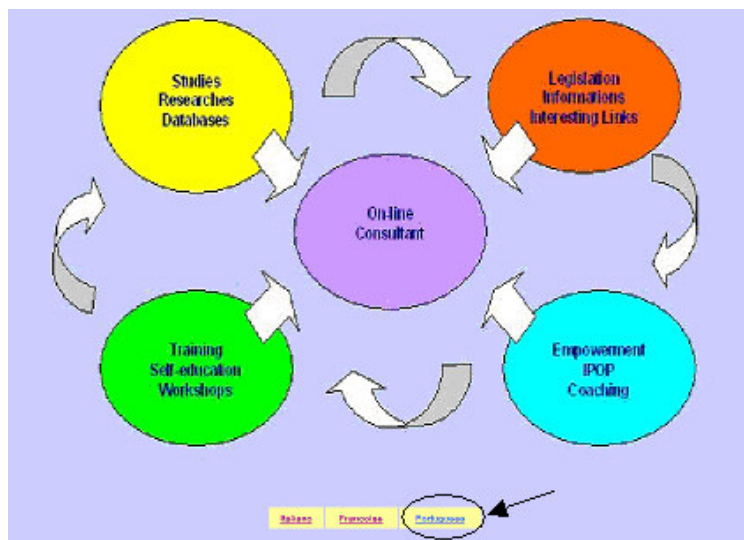
